



Drive Up Shows & Movies Information

- Drive Up Concerts & Movies take place in our parking lot, with all the classic allure of a Drive In and Outdoor Theatre wrapped into one.
- Our 16x20 stage hosts live music concerts with a full sound system; all movies are projected on our 16x20 screen, with audio broadcast on FM radio for all performances. All Drive Up Events are rain or shine.
- Please arrive at least 40 minutes prior to any Drive Up Event.
- Only two cars per pod allowed. Tickets must be purchased together to secure side-by-side parking.
- Chairs are allowed within your designated area.
- Upon arrival you will be given a map with your parking location, exit location, Car Hop Service phone number, beverage, garden, and restroom locations.
- Outside food and beverage are not permitted due to state of Maine regulations on liquor licenses.
- Security will be present at check-in and drive-out, to ensure outside food and beverages do not enter (and that open beverages do not leave) the property.
- Trash receptacles will be located at designated drive-out locations. Please do not litter.
- Please pre-order Local Partner Boxes at least 5 days prior to the event.
- We recommended that you pre-order concessions, which can be picked up upon check-in.
- A valid ID is required to order alcoholic beverages. There is a two beverage per order limit for each valid ID.
- Concessions & Car Hop Service are available at assigned parking spots throughout the first hour of the performance.
- At the end of performances cars are released by row. If your party is not ready to drive out during your row release, we ask that you wait to leave until after all other rows have been released.
- Parking is assigned according to size of vehicle in order to ensure an optimal viewing experience for all guests. Please let us know if you have a special request and we will do our best to accommodate you.
- All opened beverages will be collected during drive-out procedure. Unopened beverages can be presented to be bagged and stapled to take home. Our procedures are for your safety and to stay in compliance with State of Maine Liquor Laws.
